KEY FEATURE Reclaimed-panel wall

Best known for his Scrapwood wallpaper and furniture, Piet Hein Eek created this amazing feature wall using reclaimed doors and window frames. The trend for upcycling is still strong in the UK, with companies such as Retrouvius (retrovius.com) making everything from kitchens to outhouses entirely from salvaged materials. Contact the company to re-create a bespoke architectural feature such as this wall. Its stock is constantly changing, but expect to pay from £45 for glazed doors to £750 for large window frames.
